NEWS

The **Rules of Golf** are being updated from 1st January 2023. The R & A app will be updated with the 2023 rules and various other developments in mid-December, in the meantime a summary of the main changes is provided on the right: 

On the subject of rules – please be aware that a **ball cannot be placed on a tee peg on a fairway mat** (whether the tee is below, higher or flat to the mat). According to the club captain the only exception to this is if the mat is on a slope and the ball won't stay on the mat.

Just a reminder that the **competition fees** have increased to £3 per entry from 1st December 2022

The **boxes for donations** to local charities (animal rescues and local food bank) are in the ladies changing room. Please give what you can. The donations will be taken to the charities in January when their need is greatest. Thank you in advance.

The **Christmas Party** will take place after our competition on Saturday 17th December. If you would like to attend, please RSVP with your food choice by Friday 9th December.

NEW RULES

On Friday 18th November there was a rules evening. During the evening the changes to the Rules of Golf were presented. Here is a summary of the principal changes from 1st January 2023:-

- Multiple Penalties – only a single penalty to apply unless there is an intervening event (a stroke or awareness of a rule breach)
- Player no longer responsible for writing their handicap on a score card
- Damaged club may be replaced unless damaged by abuse
- Incorrectly substituted ball – penalty reduced from general penalty to 1 stroke penalty
- Ball moved by Natural Forces (wind, water, gravity) if ball moves to another area of the course after being dropped, placed or replaced, then it must be replaced
- Ball played from putting green accidentally hits a player, the club or an insect – it is played as it lies (not replayed)
- Changes to penalty if a ball that must be replayed, is not replayed (to avoid the risk of disqualification)
- Rules modifications for players with disabilities – new rule
- Back-on-the-line relief procedure made simpler (player must drop on the line and ball must come to rest within one club length in any direction)



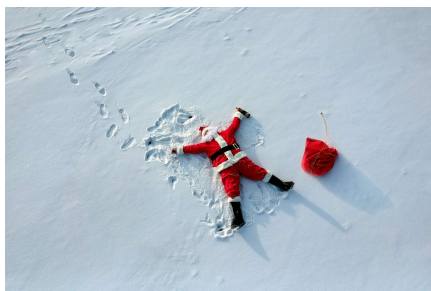
