FILLING IN A SCORE CARD CORRECTLY

AVOID THE DOUBLE 'D'

DISAPPOINTMENT AND DISQUALIFICATION

A correct score card

In golf it is really **IMPORTANT** to know how to fill in a 'score card' correctly for every competition entered.

- 1) On completion of a round all players should cross check their individual/team score with the person marking their score card.
- 2) Enter your individual/team score on Club VI and ensure the score on your card matches the score on the screen. (note: if you are in a team event it is **STRONGLY ADVISABLE** that you put the team names on the score card in the same order as they appear on the Club VI start sheet. This will make the inputting of the scores on Club VI much easier).
- 3) A clear score card allows club officials to check competition score cards (note; all cards in the frame for prizes are checked and a random selection for each competition).

Information required on a score card includes:

- Name
- Type of Competition
- Date and time
- Handicap Index, Course Handicap and Playing Handicap (individual)
- Collective Handicap (group competition)
- Correct and clear scoring according to the competition.
- Always write down the gross score no matter what the competition.
- In a stableford include your points score (this is for **YOUR** benefit as it will enable you to cross check your points score quickly at the end of the round).
- In an individual competition place your own score in the markers column of the card you are marking.
- In a team competition use the A, B and C columns and put in the team names in the order they appear on the Club V1 system. (note: if it is a 4 man team event, change marker column to D)
